

The 10 Commandments of My History Notebook

- I. Thou shalt complete all assignments in the order in which they are assigned.
- II. Thou shalt "Title" all assignments and account for each in the Table of Contents.
- III. Thou shalt *not receive credit* for Incomplete assignments. This includes LEGIBILITY! Any assignment that is not legible shall be considered incomplete and will not be graded. *If I can't read it... I can't grade it!)*
- IV. Thou shalt do all Title Pages with *full-page illustrations* and *in color*.
- V. Thou shalt complete all Cornell Notes *fully* and *each page of notes* shall contain full paragraph summaries.
- VI. Thou shalt follow proper guidelines for Reflections and Essays including formatting, vocabulary, and page lengths.
- VII. Thou shalt write in Blue or Black Ink ONLY.
- VIII. Thou shalt attach all assignments and evaluation sheets properly. (If it's loose or falls out... It will not be graded. If it's glued or stapled shut... It will not be graded. Evaluation Sheets go on the RIGHT HAND SIDE ONLY.)
- IX. Thou shalt receive a "U" in Work Habits on the following report card for any Notebook grade of 69% or lower.
- X. Thou shalt receive a "U" in Work Habits AND Cooperation for any Notebook not turned in on the Due Date. (The ONLY exception for this is an 'absence'.)
